ATTORNEY ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

ELIGIBILITY FOR ONEIDA INDIAN NATION COURT BAR ADMISSION

Applicants in good standing of the Bar of the Supreme Court of the United States, or of any United States Court of Appeals, or of any District Court of the United States or a member in good standing of the highest court of any Indian Nation or State of the United States, is eligible for admission to the Bar of Oneida Nation Court.

PROCEDURES FOR PERMANENT ADMISSION

To become permanently admitted to the court, submit the following forms along with the fee of \$50.00 (Checks are payable to: Oneida Indian Nation Court)

- 1. Petition for Admission to Practice
- 2. Oath of Admission
- 3. **Certificate of Good Standing.** One original Certificate of Good Standing from the jurisdiction where applicant was admitted is required and must be dated within six (6) months of the date of your application.

PROCEDURES FOR PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION

Any member of the Bar of the Supreme Court of the United States, or of any United States Court of Appeals, or of any District Court of the United States, or the highest Court of any Indian Nation or State of the United States, may be admitted to the Bar of this Court for limited practice motion. Limited practice shall be restricted to appearance and practice in a case or proceeding then on file in the court.

Please submit the following forms for Pro Hac Vice Admission to Practice:

- 1. Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice
- 2. Affidavit of Movant in Support of Motion
- **3. Certificate of Good Standing.** One original Certificate of Good Standing from the jurisdiction where applicant was admitted is required and must be dated within six (6) months of the date of your application.
