ONEIDA INDIAN NATION

PET ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 0-94-03

The Oneida Indian Nation hereby declares that pets running at large within the Oneida Lands are a nuisance and endangering the health and safety of the people.

1. PETS RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any owner to permit his pets to run at large.

2. IMPOUNDING ANIMALS

Any pet which appears to be lost, astray or unwanted or which is found running at large and not contained shall be picked up by and contained at an animal shelter.

3. OWNER RESPONSIBILITY FOR FEES

If a pet has to be picked up and contained the owner of the pet will be responsible for fees.

4. THIS ORDINANCE IS EFFECTIVE UPON ENACTMENT.

THIS ORDINANCE IS EFFECTIVE AS OF THE 2ND DAY OF JUNE, 1994.
