- REQUEST FORMS that fail to adhere to the guidelines will be **Denied**.
- All FORMS must be completely filled out. **Do not leave any contact information blank.**

All supporting documents should accompany the REQUEST FORM to be processed;

Missing information must be submitted into the Native American Education Unit by our deadline date.

- You must state your degree program.

_____	Submit a copy of official transcript showing your most recent GPA grades. An unofficial transcript is acceptable if it is validated by your school (signed or stamped by registrar).
_____	Letter of acceptance from college you are going to if this is a different college then previously applied for.
_____	If this is a different college then previously applied for please submit an essay with a description of your educational goals and plans.
_____	Please indicate how many credits you will be taking and the type of program you are attending.
_____	FERPA Release Information form, if you have not sent one with your initial application. You can find this form on our website: www.p12.nysed.gov/natamer or http://www.nysed.gov under Native American Education.

Students must fill out a **REQUEST FORM** EACH and EVERY semester they wish to receive funding, indicate the number of credits they will be taking with a copy of official transcript showing previous awarded semesters GPA. **TRANSCRIPTS also must be submitted before semester deadline.**

Information provided on this form will be maintained in a file by the Native American Education Unit of the New York State Education Department. The Coordinator of the Native American Education Programs, Room 1075 EBA, State Education Department, 89 Washington Ave, Albany, New York, 12234, (518) 474-0537, is responsible for the maintenance of these records. This information will be used to identify Native American students who are funded under the New York State Native American Post-Secondary Grant-in-aid Program. This information will be shared with tribal higher education offices and/or Native American tribal representatives working with higher education; higher education institutions personnel who are interested in the recruitment, admission and retention of Native American students at the undergraduate levels; and also with those institutions interested in recruiting Native Americans in opportunities for further education, scholarships, or professional training; and it will be used to recognize the degrees earned by Native Americans to share with prospective employers that may be known to the coordinator of Native American Indian Education Programs.
