SĀVON GAS STATIONS AND CONVENIENCE STORES

The Oneida Indian Nation operates the SāvOn chain of gas stations and convenience stores in Oneida and Madison counties. Each location offers a range of convenience food and other essentials such as motor oil, windshield washer fluid and batteries.

There are 9 convenient SāvOn locations:

The Oneida Nation introduced Maple Leaf Market, its newest convenience store brand in Central New York, in 2017. With a focus on providing guests with fresh, made-to-order food, Maple Leaf Market is the next generation of convenience stores that emphasizes healthier grab-and-go meal and snack choices made with fresh ingredients and freshly-brewed gourmet coffee.



Maple Leaf Market offers additional conveniences such as full-service gasoline at self-service prices, a comprehensive loyalty program, groceries and essentials.

WÁHTA' MAPLE FARM

Wáhta' Maple Farm, located in Oneida, NY, produces pure, small-batch, artisan syrup. Wholly owned by the Oneida Indian Nation, sap from the farm is harvested from a thick grove of maple trees on ancestral lands.

All maple syrup produced by Wáhta' Maple Farm is created by using sustainable sugaring practices that reflect the Oneida Indian Nation's commitment to environmental stewardship.

A collection of small-batch syrups is available at select locations including Maple Leaf Market, SávOn Convenience Stores, Turning Stone Resort Casino's General Store and Oneida Heritage, Point Place Casino, YBR Casino & Sportsbook, Sylvan Beach Supply Co. at The Cove and Shako:wi Cultural Center.



SYLVAN BEACH SUPPLY CO.

Sylvan Beach Supply Co., located at The Cove at Sylvan Beach on Oneida Lake (750 Pioneer Ave.), offers a variety of outfitting needs for beach and water sports, including paddle board, kayak, canoe, water bike, fishing supply and boat rentals.

Sylvan Beach Supply Co. also offers grab-and-go items from Turning Stone restaurants, groceries, beer, sundries, freshly brewed Utica coffee and more. Service is available inside at the counter or outside from the service window on the large deck.



MARINAS

The Oneida Indian Nation operates two marinas on Oneida Lake:

- Marion Manor Marina, located at the intersection of Routes 13 and 31 on the lake's southeast shore
- Snug Harbour located on Route 13 just south of Sylvan Beach

Marion Manor offers a bait and tackle store, boat and motor repair services, rentals, boat storage and weekly fishing reports along with a self-service boat launch and 100 available slips.

With 200 slips, a launch for boats up to 50 feet, high-speed Wi-Fi plus picnic pavilions, updated restrooms and more, Snug Harbour is the premier marina facility at the east end of Oneida Lake.

TURNING STONE CAR CARE

Turning Stone Car Care is located on Patrick Road in Verona, next to Turning Stone Resort Casino. Car Care offers routine automotive maintenance services like oil changes, car washes and detailing, as well as more involved automotive services with ASE Certified Technicians.
