Background Check

The Mary C. Winder Community Center reserves the right to conduct a background check on all members or guests of the facility. Additionally, we reserve the right to deny access or membership to any person who has been accused or convicted of any crime involving sexual abuse or those who are, have been, or become a registered sex offender.

Drug and Alcohol-Free Zone

The Mary C. Winder Community Center is a drug and alcohol-free zone. The use or possession of illegal drugs is not permitted on the premises or when participating in Oneida Indian Nation sponsored programs. We reserve the right to deny access or membership to any person who is presently or habitually under the influence of dangerous drugs or chemicals, narcotics, or intoxicating beverages.

Child Abuse Prevention

The Mary C. Winder Community Center is committed to preventing child abuse. Allegations or suspicions of child abuse are taken very seriously and will be reported to the proper authorities for investigation. We minimize opportunities for child abuse to occur and make sure youth in our programs are informed about personal space and boundaries.

Media Policy

For the privacy and security of all – especially children and teens – photos or video recording is not allowed in locker rooms, bathrooms, or in the pool area. Patrons must receive permission from the General Manager to record content at the facility.
